PUBLIC CALL FOR APPLICATIONS to attend the one-semester course for "Support to Transition Justice"

Through this announcement, the University of Pristina "Hasan Prishtina" - Faculty of Law and Community Building Mitrovica (CBM) with the support of the Royal Norwegian Embassy in Kosovo, invite all students to apply for participation in the course " Support to Transition Justice". Invited are all interested students and the course will last one semester.

The course's goal is to integrate the Transitional Justice and Peace Building in Kosovo's Higher Education, a special contribution to peace and reconciliation. This program will enable students' education in transitional justice as one of the ways to contribute towards peacebuilding.

The program introduces the topic of support for transitional justice and peacebuilding in higher education. The program also builds confidence and enhances the knowledge of Kosovo students in general and of all other actors in this field, including minorities on "Addressing the Past and Building Peace".

The program also serves as a basis for university activities leading to the development of transitional justice programs at the University of Prishtina.

The expected result is that participants in this course will:

• Build confidence and enhance deeper knowledge in understanding and

arguing justice for all students including minority institutions and other related actors;

- Will be able to work on improving understanding of the concept of transitional justice;
- Acquire knowledge and skills to actively and positively participate in transitional justice and peacebuilding issues;
- Gain in-depth knowledge of the different cases of countries that have gone through the process of transitional justice at regional and international level;
- They will be competent to transfer knowledge and skills acquired in their personal and professional environment;

After completing the lectures, students will enter the final exam to test the knowledge gained from this course or write an essay on a selected theme related to the thematic units processed throughout the course.

All attendees who will fulfil their obligations will be given a Certificate of Participation issued by the University of Prishtina "Hasan Prishtina", a program/project supported by the Embassy of the Kingdom of Norway.

The number of participants is limited. This course will be attended by 50 participants, selected on the basis of the evidence presented by the applicants, with particular care to be taken for the acceptance of participants with proportional representation of gender as well as members of different ethnic communities.
